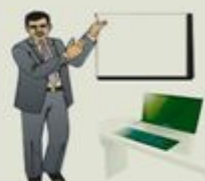

About the Organising Institutions

National Institute of Rural Development

National Institute of Rural Development (NIRD)- an Autonomous Organisation of Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India, celebrated its Golden Jubilee last year, is a premier national centre of excellence of rural development. Recognized internationally as UN-ESCAP Centre of Excellence in HRD, it builds capacities of rural development functionaries, elected representatives, academicians and young students through inter-related activities of training, research, teaching and consultancy to enable them to analyse and propose solutions to problems in planning and implementation of the programmes for rural development and disseminate information through periodicals, reports and publications. The Institute is located in the serene rural surroundings of Rajendranagar about 15 km from the Historic City of Hyderabad.

The vision of NIRD is to focus on the policies and programmes that benefit the rural poor, strive to energise the democratic decentralization process, improve the operational efficiency of rural development personnel, promote transfer of technology through its social laboratories and technology park and create environmental awareness for inclusive growth.

The Institute's services are also available at NERC(North East Regional Centre at Guwahati) and ERC(East Regional Centre at Patna) to different ministries / development departments of the Central and State Governments, Banking institutions, public and private sector organizations, civil societies, Panchayati Raj Institutions and other national and international agencies connected with rural development.

Distance Education Cell of NIRD

In view of rapid changes in communication and technology and increasing need of massive trained manpower in rural development, NIRD has established a Distance Education Cell. The Cell is mandated to initiate a number of programmes for capacity building of development personnel of Governmental Organisations, elected representatives and educated youth to function as change managers.

University of Hyderabad (UoH)

The University of Hyderabad, a premier institution of post-graduate teaching and research in the country, was established as a Central University- first in Southern India. In addition to federal funding, it receives substantial research funding and support from other resources from home and abroad, and attracts the best students, faculty from all over India. The University is located on the old Hyderabad-Bombay Highway, about 20 km from the city of Hyderabad.

The University is one of the five universities in India which have been accorded the status of University with Potential for Excellence by the University Grant Commission (UGC). The National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) have accorded the University the top rating of "Five Stars". The university is a Member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), the Association of Common Wealth Universities (ACU), and International Council for Distance Education (ICDE).

Centre for Distance Education of UoH

To increase access to higher education for all sections of society, the Centre introduced a number of specialized P.G.Diploma Programmes which are popular both in India and abroad.

About the Programme

The sustainable rural development is basically the development which meets the need of present generation of rural people without compromising the capacity of future generations to fulfil their own needs. This entails sustained efforts to raise the quality of life of rural people. Huge efforts are being made in India and so also other developing countries to develop their rural areas in order to reduce Urban-Rural divide by creating conducive environment for resource development and utilization through up -grading knowledge and skills of the people to make the best use of available resources. What is required is large number of capable human resources who will function as change managers, which this P.G. Diploma Programme sets out to produce. The enrolled students will have unique opportunity to access best learning resources for developing strong perspective and technical capability for developing and managing rural development projects on their own. They will be trained to be professionals with difference.

Programme Objectives

To prepare competent rural development professionals who will be well equipped with:

- Concepts, approaches and opportunities of sustainable development;
- Knowledge about the human and natural / non-natural resources and their sustainable use;
- Knowledge about policies and programmes of central and state governments pertaining to rural development;
- Best practises in institutional arrangements for sustainable development in developing countries;
- High skills to develop and implement projects for application of sustainability concepts to accelerate rural development efforts in India and other developing countries.

Eligibility

- The minimum qualification for admission to the Programme is graduation in any discipline from a recognised University. Those who are in the final year and expect to complete all the requirements of graduation before enrolment date are also eligible.
- Apart from fresh graduates, the development personnel working in:
 - Rural development, agriculture (and allied sectors) and education sectors.
 - Non-Governmental Organisations / cooperatives / finance and banking organisations.
 - Corporate sector under corporate social responsibility.
- Faculty of various development disciplines, Rural Development, Economics, Political Science, Gender studies, Management, Agriculture and other allied discipline from universities, colleges, Training Institutions like State Institutes of Rural Development (SIRD), Extension Training Institutes (ETIs), Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVKs), Agriculture Education, Research and Training Institutions can also join the course.

Duration One year, maximum three years

Student Support Services

Learning resources

- Printed self instructional material
- Audio - visual cassettes and educational CDs/VCDs.
- Web-based on-line learning resources (include video graphed lectures)
- Networked video conferencing at selected centres
- Two compulsory Contact sessions of 6-7 days each, one in 1st Semester and another in 2nd Semester will be conducted in NIRD; UoH, Hyderabad; NERC of NIRD, Guwahati; ERC of NIRD, Patna and in select centres in the each state / region of the country.

Course structure and contents

The Programme will be offered in two semesters and have 35 credits. 1st Semester will have 15 credits and 2nd, 20 credits. One credit is equal to 30 hours of study. The Programme will have four courses plus project in 1st Semester and three courses plus project in the 2nd Semester.

Evaluation

The evaluation system is designed to test the student's progress systematically through internal assessment as well as semester-end examinations. Following evaluations will be made:

1. Assignments	20 %
2. Contact classes , Counselling/Practical / Term Papers / Lab Test	20 %
3. Semester -end Final Examination	60 %

Minimum two assignments in each course with at least minimum marks to be eligible to appear in the final examination. The projects of the students will be evaluated by identified Counsellor / Guide at designated Agency.

Programme Fee:

Admitted students will deposit Rs 17,000/- (Rs 15,000/- for SC /ST /PH) in two equal instalments at the commencement of each Semester. The Sponsoring Organisations, however, have to deposit full fee at the time of registration of their candidate(s).

Fee for Foreign Students / NRIs:

Admitted students will deposit as Programme Fee of US\$ 1700 at the commencement of First Semester.

How to apply:

The willing students will have to apply by filling detachable application form with this Brochure by paying an application fee of Rs 500/- (Rs 300/- for SC / ST / PH candidates) through Demand Draft in favour of National Institute of Rural Development, payable at Hyderabad (on reverse side of draft, name of applicant and name of Programme to be written). For obtaining the application forms by post, the students should send a self- addressed envelope of 12" x 10" size along with a DD for Rs 510/- (Rs 310/- for SC/ST/PH) to Programme Coordinator. Duly filled forms along with application fee should be sent to **Programme Co-ordinator, PGD- SRD, Distance Education Cell, NIRD, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad- 500 030 (AP) .**

Last dates: Duly filled application forms to be received by 31st December, 2009. For students residing in North-Eastern States, the last date is 31st December, 2009.

For Foreign students / NRIs, the last date of receiving application is 31st December, 2009. This fee can be remitted in favour of DECPGDSRD, State Bank of Hyderabad, NIRD Branch, Hyderabad.
