ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Though there has been an impressive growth in terms of savings bank accounts, bank branches, business correspondents, Kisan Credit Cards, etc. during the last five decades, still it is a long way to go in achieving 100 per cent financial inclusion in India. Therefore, it is pertinent to create awareness among the stakeholders and ensure smooth completion of the mission.

Further, most of the Self Help Group members reach a point where they could not graduate to the next level of entrepreneurship due to various reasons such as lack of financial literacy, requisite management skills, technical knowhow, market linkages, value addition for their products & services, adequate supply of credit, change in the government's policy, etc. In view of the above, this training programme is intended to impart training to the field level trainers so that they will improve the skill repertoire of members of SHGs.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

- ❖ To update with latest instructions & developments on financial inclusion, with special reference to SHG-BLP for the benefit of participants from SIRD & ETCs
- ❖ To enable for training of grass root level performers in the field of financial inclusion & SHG Bank Linkage Programmes.
- ❖ To transmit the feedback from the participants to the concerned authorities for improvising the programme, if any.

CONTENT OF THE PROGRAMME

The programme covers various aspects of financial inclusion, inclusive micro finance, role of micro finance in poverty alleviation, conceptual background of SHG-BLP and its implementation, digital innovations like Stree Nidhi in rural credit, sustainable rural livelihoods, activities of NRLM & DDU-GKY, social enterprises, apart from case studies, group discussions and sharing of experiences by the participants.

OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAMME

At the end of the training programme, the participants will gain adequate knowledge on concepts of financial inclusion, SHG Bank Linkage Programme, etc. which will benefit them for onward dissemination to the members of SHGs.
